- Supports existing curriculum.

Our ICT timeline and implementation strategy includes

- 2003 – Networking plan and needs assessment via Central Office.
- 2004/5 – provision of computers throughout the school
- 2006 / 08 Networking of entire school to be completed as per DET requirements.
- 2006/ 2007 Establishment of computer lab for entire school.
- 2008 Development of additional computer lab
- 2009 Interactive Whiteboards in all teaching areas.
- By 2008 networking of computers in all classrooms.
- By 2009 a ratio of 2:1 computers throughout the entire school
- By 2009 development of ICT plans to purchase equipment to enhance digital usage throughout the school.
- To continue to develop teaching and learning skills using ICT.
- Ensure a succession plan for network management and maintenance.

Our Success

- Funding from BIS Clean away, DET, BHP and St Barbara mines to develop a robust ICT plan implementation.
